## Pro Trade CRAFT For Residential Construction Pros

Step Flashing a Roof to a Brick Wall

1. Locate inside corner at least 4 in. above roof deck.

**2.** Waterproof block and roof/wall gap with peel and stick membrane.

3. Cap the block with membrane extending back to the sheathing and covering


**4.** Turn the end up on the bottom pan, to kick water out.

**5.** Subsequent pans have the end turned over previous pan.

**6.** Counterflashing locks into hook in pan flashing and tucks behind the vertical strip.

**7.** Two layers of house wrap or felt overlap flashing legs.

8. Weep mesh in every pan allows drainage.
